

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING



BETWEEN
ITM University, Gwalior, Madhya Pradesh
AND
Pandit S. N. Shukla University, Shahdol, Madhya Pradesh
FOR
Conducting Workshops and Collaborative Research

This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is made on this 26th day of March, 2025, by and between:

- **ITM University**, an institution of higher education located in Gwalior, Madhya Pradesh, India (hereinafter referred to as "Party A"), and
- **Pandit S. N. Shukla University**, an institution of higher education located in Shahdol, Madhya Pradesh, India, established in 2016 by the Government of Madhya Pradesh (hereinafter referred to as "Party B").

Both institutions shall hereinafter be collectively referred to as the "Parties" and individually as a "Party".

1. OBJECTIVE

The primary objective of this MoU is to establish a framework for cooperation between the Parties to conduct workshops, seminars, and collaborative research projects scheme, aimed at enhancing the quality of higher education and fostering innovation.

2. SCOPE OF COOPERATION

The cooperation between the Parties shall include but not be limited to the following areas:

1.1 Workshops and Seminars:

- Organizing joint workshops, seminars, and training programs for students and faculty members.
- Focusing on skill development, emerging technologies, and interdisciplinary research areas.

1.2 Collaborative Research:

- Undertaking joint research projects in areas of mutual interest.
- Applying for funding for research grants and resources.



1.3 Faculty and Student Exchange:

- Facilitating exchange programs for faculty and students to promote knowledge sharing and skill enhancement.

1.4 Resource Sharing:

- Sharing of research facilities, laboratories, and libraries to support joint initiatives.
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3. RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE PARTIES

3.1 ITM University:

- Provide technical expertise, resource persons, and infrastructure support for workshops.
- Assist in preparing joint research proposals for funding.

3.2 Pandit S. N. Shukla University:

- Facilitate the participation of students and faculty in workshops and research activities.
 - Coordinate with local authorities for smooth execution of collaborative projects.
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4. FUNDING AND FINANCIAL ARRANGEMENTS

- Both Parties shall explore funding opportunities and other relevant government schemes.
 - Expenses shall be mutually decided and shared based on project requirements and funding availability.
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5. INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS (IPR)

- The intellectual property rights arising out of the collaborative research shall be jointly owned by the Parties unless otherwise agreed upon in writing.
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6. DURATION AND TERMINATION

- This MoU shall be effective for a period of **3 years** from the date of signing and may be extended upon mutual agreement.
 - Either Party may terminate this MoU by giving a written notice of **90 days**.
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7. DISPUTE RESOLUTION

- Any disputes arising out of this MoU shall be resolved amicably through mutual discussions.
- If unresolved, disputes shall be referred to arbitration as per the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996.

8. AMENDMENTS

- Any amendments to this MoU shall be made in writing and signed by both Parties.

9. MISCELLANEOUS

- This MoU does not create any legal or financial obligations beyond those explicitly stated.
