This Memorandum of Understanding is made and entered into on this the 29th day of in the month Jan., 2020 between **ITM University Gwalior** (hereinafter called "ITMU") represented by its **Vice Chancellor** which expression shall mean include its executors, successors and permitted assigns, of the FIRST PART

AND

PROFESSOR JAYASHANKAR TELANGANA STATE AGRICULTURAL UNIVERSITY situated at Rajendranagar, Hyderabad – 500030, Telangana State (hereinafter called "PJ TSAU") represented by its **Registrar** which expression shall mean include its executors, successors and permitted assigns, of the SECOND PART.

ITM University Gwalior is a multidisciplinary university with an international reputation for the quality of its research and teaching across the academic spectrum covering the domain of agriculture, physical and life sciences, engineering, management, commerce, fine arts, social sciences, arts, nursing, education etc. It was established in 2011 under the State Legislative Act of Madhya Pradesh Govt. and duly recognized by UGC Act under 2(f) with authorization to confer Degrees/Diplomas under 22(1) of the UGC Act for its various courses. The ITM University received approvals of UGC, AICTE, CoA, NCI, PCI, ICAR, NCTE etc. and is accredited by NAAC.

PROFESSOR JAYASHANKAR TELANGANA STATE AGRICULTURAL UNIVERSITY (PJ TSAU) is a statewide University established by the Act of state Legislature i.e. PJ TSAU Act 1963 is the only Farm University of Telangana State which came into existence after formation of separate Telangana State due to bifurcation of Acharya NG Ranga Agricultural University (ANGRAU). The PJ TSAU works towards the education of the rural people in agriculture in its broadest sense to promote research, field and extension programmes in agriculture and agricultural production. It also works on improving technologies to improve farm production and income to farmers.

Memorandum of Understanding for Academic Co-Operation between
ITM University, Gwalior, M.P.

Professor Jayashankar Telangana State Agricultural University (PJ TSAU), Hyderabad

Both the parties wish to initiate collaboration in the areas of mutual understanding in education and research in different disciplines of Agricultural Sciences and other allied fields. Therefore, both parties agree to establish a programme for academic co-operation in areas of mutual interest in accordance with terms and conditions set forth in this memorandum of understanding (MoU).

Objective:

The goal of this MOU is to have collaboration, provide opportunity for student community and to facilitate advancement of knowledge on basis of reciprocity, mutual benefit and frequent interactions. ITMU and PJTSAU agree to explore the possibilities of engaging in the following modes of collaboration:

- Exchange of information on teaching, research, extension, learning materials and other literature relevant to their educational and research programmes;
- Joint organization of seminars conferences, short term educational programmes on topics of mutual interest by extending invitations to each other's faculty to participate there in;
- Joint proposal and engagement in research and teaching while extending invitation to each other's faculty;
- Exchange of facilities available at both the Organizations for academic, research and undertaking projects;
- To start collaborative research projects for strengthening the research in Biotechnology, Environmental Science, Plant Sciences and Natural Resource Management between both the Organizations.
- Exchange of students at Post Graduate and Ph.D level for the purpose of education and research.
- To make reciprocally, provision for in-service staff of ITMU/PJTSAU for admission into Ph.D program in PJTSAU/ITMU under the provisions in their respective ordinances.
- To allow the faculty of PJTSAU/ITMU to be on the advisory committee of such students for PG & Ph.D programmes offered by both universities.

Finances and other obligations:

No financial commitment is associated for academic co-operation in areas of mutual interests and in accordance with terms and conditions set forth in this memorandum of understanding. No party to this memorandum shall use the name, logo or any other designation of the other party without prior written consent.

Co-ordination:

The Registrar/Dean will be authorized to co-ordinate the programme on behalf of their respective institutions. They will periodically review and identify ways and means to strengthen co-operation between the two institutions.

Tenure and Termination:

This MOU will take effect from the date it is signed by representatives of the two institutions. It will remain valid for a period of Two (2) years. Any extension to this MOU will be formally agreed in writing by the parties. Either institution may terminate the MOU by giving written notice to the other institution three months in advance. Once terminated, neither ITMU nor PJTSAU will be responsible for any losses, financial or otherwise, which the other institution may suffer. However, the institutions, ITMU and PJTSAU will ensure that all activities in progress are allowed to complete successfully.

Arbitration Clause:

In case of any dispute relating to any academic / research co-operation, the registrar of ITMU and the registrar of PJTSAU will jointly resolve the dispute in a spirit of mutual understanding, mutual respect and shared responsibility.
