#### MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

This MoU made and entered into on this 1st day of May 2024.

#### Between

ITM University, Gwalior, which expression shall where the context so admits, include its successors and permitted assigns). The University is signing MOU through its Vice Chancellor, presently Prof. (Dr.) Yogesh Upadhyay duly authorized to enter into and sign an MOU on behalf of School of Pharmacy, ITM University (hereinafter called SOP ITMU) PARTY OF THE FIRST PART.

#### And

**K.R. Mangalam University**, a University established under the Haryana Private Universities Act 2006 (Amended 08 of 2013) and under section 2(f) of UGC Act, 1956 wherein empowered to award degrees, as specified under section 22 of the UGC Act, 1956. The University is signing MOU through its Registrar duly authorized to enter into and sign an MOU on behalf of School of Medical and Allied Science, K.R. Mangalam University (hereinafter called **SMAS**, **KRMU**), **PARTY OF THE SECOND PART**.

Believing in the significance of academic and cultural understanding and cooperation, ITM University Gwalior, India and the K. R. Mangalam University, Gurugram, Haryana, have agreed to initiate the process to enhance relations, exchange of expertise, and boost academic development for both the university which will also be in the general interest of students and staff at both the university. This general agreement for collaboration is a step in the said direction and delineates the main features of cooperation between the two organizations, particularly in academic development, research, exchange of faculty, exchange of students, Internships, Jointly award Master degree, Dissertation and Thesis related visits of students self funding with accommodation in institute premises, Invite scholars to give lectures, faculty and staff, and development of educational opportunities to enrich campus internationalization at each university. While this agreement is not to be considered a contract, the following articles shall be explored and discussed by both parties in good will and in good faith.

#### Article 1

ITM University Gwalior, India (ITMU) hereinafter shall be referred to as "the First Party" and the K. R. Mangalam University, Gurugram, Haryana, hereinafter shall be referred to as "the Second Party," have agreed to explore the possibility of establishing a relationship in order to advance global understanding, research, teaching relationships and faculty and student exchanges.

Cohna Road Gurugram (Harvana)

Article 2

Both the parties shall endeavor to encourage faculty and staff from both universities to

explore possible areas where instruction can be enriched through an electronic forum between

classes. The purpose of the electronic forum would be to connect undergraduate or graduate

students in Gwalior to students in the Gurugram around a specific course topic, problem, or

research project for the purpose of providing students with greater global perspectives on the

course content or discipline. Both the university will discuss the mechanism, technicalities of

delivering video conferencing, an electronic forum, and/or web-based chat rooms and if the

terms and conditions, financial implications are mutually agreed by and between the two

universities, an agreement shall be executed between the parties incorporating all the agreed

terms and conditions, which will be signed by the designated authorized persons from both

the parties.

Article 3

Both the university shall explore the feasibility of developing number of academic curriculum

partnerships. These may ultimately be in the form of dual-degree (2X2 or similar

configuration), or other creative curriculum partnerships to enrich undergraduate and/or

graduate study opportunities.

Article 4

Both the parties will explore the possibility of creating awareness of the undergraduate and

graduate programs available at the partner institution, advising students as to the criteria and

deadlines for admission, and accordingly assist students with the submission of applications

to the graduate programs.

Article 5

Both the parties shall encourage the exchange of faculty and staff from both universities for

teaching, professional development, and/or research endeavors; and/or encourage staff to

carry out non-residential partnerships to develop academic and scientific research in areas

and fields of interest to both parties.

Article 6

Both the parties agree to encourage the offering of short, specialized courses and training

sessions in areas needed by both University (for example, through short-term summer

"Discovery" Programs hosted on the campus).

Article 7

Both the parties shall encourage student visits from both universities. However before

implementing, all procedures, mechanisms to study, the cost and share of both the parties to

implement these visits, terms and conditions including financial implications for the universities if mutually agreed by and between the parties hereto shall be incorporated in an agreement to be executed between the parties.

#### **Article 8**

Both the parties will encourage exchanges of ideas, processes and procedures in student life and campus leadership.

#### Article 9

One liaison officer from each institute will be appointed to follow up the implementation of the agreement and to brief the officials in both universities about progress achieved.

#### Article 10

Notwithstanding anything to the contrary stated herein, both parties herein agree that before implementing any program/activities under this arrangement, the parties will, negotiate, discuss all the terms and conditions including financial and other implications on both the universities and if both parties mutually agree, the agreed terms and conditions shall be so recorded in writing in an agreement to be executed by and between the parties and shall be signed by the authorized representative of the parties herein.

#### Article 11

MOU shall become effective on the date it is signed by the parties and shall be valid for three (3) years. Both the parties review the status of the MOU at the end of three year period from the date of commencement to determine any modification, whenever necessary. The period of MOU may be extended by mutual consent up to next two years. This MOU is amended by mutual written consent and agreement and may be terminated at any time by party upon written notification signed by competent authority of the party initiating termination without any financial or legal implication on either side. Such notification must be given to the other party at least six months in advance from the effective date of termination.

#### Article 12

Any disputes and for controversy arising from the interpretation or application and implementation of this agreement shall be settled amicably through consultation or negotiation by the particles within the spirit of collaboration or otherwise All disputes arising out of or in connection with this agreement shall be referred to the sole arbitration appointed with the consent of the authorized person of both the parties and the award passed by the sole arbitrator shall be final and binding on both the parties. The place of arbitration will be decided with the convenience of both the parties.
