

ORDINANCE NO - 74

1.	Degree Title	Master of Physical Education (M.P.Ed.)
2.	Duration of the Course	Minimum 2 Years (4 Semesters) Maximum 3 Years (Semesters)
3.	Minimum Eligibility	Candidates who have passed (a) Bachelor of Physical Education (B.P.Ed.) or equivalent with at least 50% marks OR Bachelor of Science (B.Sc.) in Health and Physical Education or equivalent with at least 50% marks. (b) The reservation in seats and relaxation in the qualifying marks for SC/ST/OBC/PWD and other categories shall be as per the rules of the Central/State Government whichever is applicable. As per Appendix-8 of NCTE Regulation.
4.	Admission Procedure	On merit, on the basis of the qualifying examination/entrance examination following norms of the concerned regulatory body NCTE and approved by Admission Board of University.
5.	Total Seats	Decided by Admission Board / Academic Council of University as per norms of the concerned regulatory body NCTE and subject to revision from time to time.
6.	Examination	Examination will be conducted as per the appropriate statutes and ordinances in this respect. The scheme of the examinations, promotion to subsequent semesters and course of the studies shall be as per the recommendations of the concerned Board of studies with due approval of Academic Council. For matters not covered in this ordinance, general rules and regulation shall be applicable. For all other matters, the decision of the Board of Management shall be binding. The medium of examination will be Hindi or English only.
7.	Eligibility	Eligibility for Award of the Master of Physical Education (M.P.Ed.) A student shall be declared to be eligible for award of the Master of Physical Education (M.P.Ed.) degree if he/she has: a) registered and successfully completed all the core courses and projects; b) successfully acquired the minimum required credits as specified in the regulations corresponding to the branch of his/ her study within the stipulated time; c) earned the specified credits in all the categories of subjects; d) secured a CGPA of 5.0.
8.	Attendance Requirement	A candidate must have at least 75% attendance. In case the attendance is less than 75%, special permission of Vice Chancellor shall be required.
9.	General Instructions and Provision	For matters not covered in this specific ordinance general rules and regulation of University regarding specific courses are applicable. In other matters, Academic Council / Board of Management shall be competent to take any decision.
