

ABOUT GWALIOR

Gwalior is a historical city of India which is situated in Madhya Pradesh. It is located to the south of Agra, 319 km south of Delhi and 423 km North of Bhopal. Gwalior occupies a strategic in the Gird Region of India and centers of several historic north Indian Kingdoms. It is famous for Gwalior Fort also known as PEARL OF FORT which has changed thrones many times. From the Tomars in the 18th century, it passed to the Mughals, then the Marathas under the Scindias (1754). It is also administrative Head quarter of Narcotics Commissioner of India, Defence Research and Development Establishment (DRDE) and several other Head Quarters of the state. Gwalior is one of the largest cities of Central India and is often referred to as the tourist capital of the Madhya Pradesh. The climate of Gwalior is sub-tropical and rainy season ends by middle of September. In the third week of April, the ambient microclimate of Gwalior is fine and moderate, maximum temperature will be around 40 degree celcius and minimum temperature will be around 30 degree celcius. Nearby places to visit Agra, Orcha, Madhav Tiger Reserve Shivpuri.

CONNECTIVITY TO GWALIOR

Gwalior is well connected by air and rail from major Indian cities including Delhi, Mumbai, Bengaluru, and Hyderabad. The city is served by Rajmata Vijaya Raje Scindia Airport (GWL), located just 8 km from the city centre, and Gwalior Junction, a major railway hub with frequent express and premium train services, ensuring convenient access for delegates across the country.
