

# Key Responsibility Areas (KRA) and Key Performance Indicators (KPI) for Hostel Warden

### 1. Student Welfare & Discipline

- KRA: Ensure safety, discipline, and well-being of hostel residents.
- KPIs:
  - Number of disciplinary cases reported per semester (target: minimal / reduced trend).
  - Timely resolution of student grievances (e.g., within 48 hours).
  - Conduct of at least one monthly meeting with hostel representatives.
  - Student satisfaction score (via periodic survey ≥ 80%).

#### 2. Safety & Security Management

- **KRA**: Maintain a secure hostel environment.
- KPIs<sup>1</sup>
  - Zero incidents of theft, ragging, or violence reported.
  - Functionality of security systems (CCTV, entry logs, fire alarms) ≥ 95%.
  - Conduct quarterly safety drills (fire/evacuation).
  - o Daily attendance and gate-pass monitoring accuracy ≥ 98%.

#### 3. Hostel Administration & Operations

- KRA: Ensure smooth day-to-day operations of hostel facilities.
- KPIs:
  - Timely allocation of rooms and record keeping (100% updated records).
  - o Response time to maintenance complaints ≤ 24 hours for minor issues, ≤ 72 hours for major ones.
  - Hostel occupancy rate maintained above 90%.
  - Zero backlog in inventory management (beds, furniture, linens, etc.).

## 4. Mess & Hygiene Management

- KRA: Supervise quality of food and cleanliness of hostel premises.
- KPIs:
  - Monthly hygiene audit score ≥ 85%.
  - Number of food-related complaints resolved within 48 hours.



- Conduct surprise checks everyday in mess and sanitation areas.
- Regular pest-control and waste-disposal compliance (quarterly).

### 5. Student Engagement & Mentorship

- KRA: Promote a healthy and inclusive living-learning culture.
- KPIs:
  - o Organize at least 2 hostel cultural/sports/community activities per semester.
  - Maintain mentor-mentee interaction logs (100% coverage).
  - Student participation rate in hostel activities ≥ 70%.

## 6. Compliance & Reporting

- **KRA**: Ensure adherence to university policies, government regulations, and hostel rules.
- KPIs:
  - o 100% compliance with anti-ragging, safety, and fire norms.
  - o Submission of monthly hostel management report to Dean/VC office.
  - Zero non-compliance issues raised during internal/external audits.

## 7. Financial & Resource Management

- KRA: Manage hostel budget, expenses, and resources effectively.
- KPIs:
  - Hostel expenses maintained within approved budget (±5% variance).
  - Timely submission of expenditure statements (monthly/quarterly).
  - o Reduction in wastage of electricity, water, and food by at least 10% annually.
