Candidates should have secured at least 40% marks in aggregate in the qualifying examination (10th). |
| 6. Admission Procedure | On merit, on the basis of the qualifying examination / entrance examination as per the norms of the concerned regulatory body UGC and approved by Admission Board of ITM University Gwalior.
The Reservation of SC, ST, OBC and Physically handicapped shall be as per rules of State/Central Govt. and Regulatory Body.
Admission will be as per the norms of Government of M. P., Department of Higher Education. |
| 7. Total Seats | Decided by Admission Board of ITM University Gwalior as per norms of the concerned regulatory body UGC and subject to revision from time to time. |
| 8. Examination | Examinations will be conducted as per the appropriate statutes and ordinances in this respect. The scheme of examinations, promotion to subsequent semesters and course of studies shall be as per the recommendations of the concerned Board of Studies with due approval of Academic Council. For matters not covered in this ordinance, General rules and regulation shall be applicable. For all other matters, the decision of the Board of Management shall be binding. The examination shall consist of theory & practical i. e. 40% and 60% respectively. |
| 9. Eligibility for Degree | Eligibility for Award of the Diploma (fashion design)
A student shall be declared to be eligible for award of the diploma if he/she has:
(a) registered and successfully completed all the core courses and projects;
(b) successfully acquired the minimum required credits as specified in the regulations corresponding to the branch of his/her study within the stipulated time;
(c) earned the specified credits in all the categories of subjects;
(d) secured a CGPA of 5.0 for obtaining Diploma degree.
(e) no dues to the University, Hostels, Libraries, NCC / NSS / NSO etc.

(f) No disciplinary action is pending against him/her. |

10. Attendance Requirement

A candidate must have at least 75% attendance.

11. General Instructions and Provisions

For matters not covered in this specific ordinance general rules and regulation of ITM University Gwalior regarding specific courses are applicable. In other matters Board of Management of ITM University Gwalior shall be competent to take any decision.

AMENDMENT NOTIFICATION

No. R-19-cc-2016-XXXVIII - In exercise of the powers conferred of Section 29 of the Madhya Pradesh Niji Vishwavidyalaya (Sthapna Avam Sanchalan) Adhiniyam, 2007 the State Government hereby makes the Amendment Notification of the ITM University Gwalior.

1. They shall come into force from the date of their publication.

2. Amendment in the ordinance No.32

i) In ordinance No.32 section 3 the duration of course "Minimum 1 Year (2 Semesters), Maximum 1½ Year (3 Semesters)" shall be substituted by "Minimum 1 Year (Yearly), Maximum 2 Years (Yearly)".

ii) In ordinance No.32 section 5 the minimum eligibility shall be substituted by candidates who have passed

Final examination of the 10+2 system conducted by any recognised Central/State Board, such as Central Board of Secondary Education, New Delhi; Council for Indian School Certificate Examination, New Delhi etc.

OR

Final examination of the two year course of the Joint Services wing of the National Defence Academy.

OR

General Certificate Education (GCE) Examination (London- Cambridge/ Sri Lanka) or equivalent.

OR

Senior Secondary School Examination conducted by the National open schooling with a minimum of five subjects.

OR

Any public school/ Board/ University examination in India or in any foreign Country recognized as equivalent to 10+2 system by the Association of Indian Universities (AIU).

And

Candidate should have secured passing marks in their qualifying examination.
