Activity: Community Visit Program

Date-: 8April 2024 Venue Antari Village

Objective:

- Education: To educate community members about the transmission, prevention, and treatment of communicable diseases, including proper hygiene practices and vaccination.
- Risk Reduction: To raise awareness about behaviors and practices that can increase the risk of contracting communicable diseases and promote strategies to minimize these risks.
- Early Detection: To promote early detection of communicable diseases by educating community members about common symptoms and encouraging regular health screenings.
- Community Engagement: To engage community members in discussions and activities aimed at addressing misconceptions, stigma, and discrimination associated with communicable diseases.
- Resource Mobilization: To mobilize resources and support for preventive measures, such as access to clean water, sanitation facilities, and healthcare services.
- Partnership Building: To establish partnerships with local healthcare providers, community leaders, and organizations to strengthen the community's response to communicable diseases.

- Monitoring and Evaluation: To monitor the effectiveness of awareness campaigns and interventions in reducing the incidence and impact of communicable diseases and evaluate the program's outcomes and impact on community knowledge, attitudes, and practices.

Report:

Community Visit Program was commemorated with various events and activities, including educational seminars, health screenings, awareness campaigns, and social media initiatives. Healthcare professionals and organizations collaborated to disseminate information about diabetes risk factors, symptoms, and lifestyle interventions for prevention. Free blood sugar screenings were conducted in communities, and individuals were encouraged to undergo regular check-ups for early detection and management of diabetes



Outcome:

The Community visit program, yielded several positive outcomes:

- 1. Enhanced understanding and awareness of communicable diseases among community members.
- 2. Increased adoption of preventive measures and healthy behaviors to reduce disease transmission.
- 3. Strengthened community engagement and collaboration in disease prevention efforts.
- 4. Reduction in stigma and discrimination associated with communicable diseases through education and awareness.
- 5. Improved access to healthcare services and resources for early detection and treatment.
- 6. Establishment of sustainable partnerships and networks to support ongoing disease prevention initiatives.





AND

ITM University Gwalior, ITM University Turari Campus, NH-44, BypassTurari, Jhansi Road Gwalior, 475001, Madhya Pradesh, India. **IDS and ITM University Gwalior shall be together referred as "Parties"** and individually as "Party".

RECITALS

- WHEREAS ITM University Gwalior, ITM University Turari Campus, NH-44,BypassTurari, Jhansi Road Gwalior, 475001, Madhya Pradesh, India is one of the topranking universities in Gwalior with over hundreds and hundreds of full-time students and faculties across all the ITM University Campus – offering a wide range of programs.
- WHEREAS IDS is in the business of developing next-generation solutions in new and emerging business areas such as Artificial Intelligence, Blockchain, Cloud, Internet of Things (loT).
- 3. WHEREAS **IDS** shall establish Applied Blockchain Centre (ABC), a Blockchain Lab facility at ITM University, Gwalior under this MoU.

1. Purpose

With the objective of promoting their co-operation in academic education and research, IDS has set up Applied Blockchain Centre ("Lab") on a shared facility by ITM University, Gwalior to address 3 key areas but not limited to the below.

- Blockchain for Textile, Food Processing and Agriculture sector
- Hedera Distributed Ledger Technology/Blockchain use cases and Implementations
- Use cases of National Interest on Bharat Blockchain Network

Parties wish to give access to the Lab facility to the selected students and faculty of ITM University, Gwalior in relation to course hands on sessions/research work ("Researchers") under UG/PG programs.

- f) Any other activities which may be mutually agreed in writing between the parties for the promotion of the Lab and the research therein.
- g) The pricing for the certification program and expected Outcomes/ Deliverables is as stated in Appendix.

3. Commencement, Renewal, Termination

This MoU will be effective from the date of the last signature here to and will remain in force for a time of 2 years ("Term"), with a possibility for renewal at the end of this Term, subject to the Parties' written agreement. Either Party may terminate this Agreement by giving three (3) months' notices in writing to the other Party. In case of termination, both parties will ensure the existing students/faculty are not affected regarding ongoing training, projects or any other activity.

4. Confidentiality

In terms of this MOU, will be governed by the NDA between the Parties.

Further the Parties agree that IDS may require the Interns or Researchers to sign a separate internship agreement and/or confidentiality agreement or any other similar agreement which provides such internship or lab access details and other terms. In case of any ambiguity or conflict of terms between the terms and conditions of this MoU and those of these internship agreements and/or confidentiality agreement, the terms and conditions of such internship agreement and/or confidentiality agreement shall prevail.

5. IP Rights

- a) Nothing in this MoU is intended to grant to ITM University Gwalior, any rights under any patent, trade secret or copyright or work done by the students or Researchers in IDS products or services nor shall this MoU grant ITM University Gwalior any rights in or to Confidential information, except the limited right to review, subject to compliance with all terms and conditions, information solely for the purpose of this MoU. All rights in such work shall vest with both parties.
- b) In the event of any patent or copyright that arises under this MoU, the same shall be filed in the joint name of IDS and ITM University Gwalior on terms to be agreed in advance by IDS.
- c) All research, white papers, patents, collaboration etc. under this MoU may only be published upon the prior review and express written confirmation by IDS and upon providing appropriate acknowledgement of IDS in such materials/works

6. Legal Relationship

This MoU shall be construed as a statement of purpose to promote a genuine and mutually beneficial collaboration between the Parties. Nothing in this MoU shall create any legal relationship between the Parties.

ITM University Gwalior agrees to indemnify and hold IDS harmless against any its Affiliates, and their respective officers, directors, agents and employees against all liabilities, costs, expenses, damages and losses suffered or incurred by IDS caused by Interns, Researchers, or/and arising out of any act or omission of ITM University Gwalior in connection with this MoU.

IDS shall not be liable to the institute for any loss of profit, business, savings or goodwill or any direct, indirect or consequential losses or exemplary or punitive damages, whether caused by breach of contract (including this MoU), negligence, breach of any statutory duty or arising in any other way, in every case even if the relevant party has been advised of the possibility of that type of loss.
