

INTERNSHIP POLICY

Your Path to Industry Readiness

1

Internship is Mandatory

Every student must complete the prescribed internship to earn internship credits.

2

After 2nd Semester

You may undertake an Online/Virtual Internship (Mode C) to build technical skills.

3

2nd & 3rd Year

You are strongly encouraged to complete an Industry Internship (Mode A) in a recognized organization.

4

Didn't Get an Industry Internship?

Join the Department-Sponsored Internship (Mode B) and successfully complete the assigned Live Project.

5

Live Project is Compulsory

A Live Project is mandatory for all internship modes.

6

Register Your Internship

Get your internship approved and registered with the Department before starting.

7

Submit Required Documents

Internship Certificate, Project Report and Project Presentation/Viva must all be submitted.

8

Fake Internships = No Credits

Only verified internships will be accepted. Fake certificates or projects will lead to disciplinary action.

Internship Modes

Mode	Name	Description
Mode A	Industry Internship (Preferred)	Internship in a recognized company / startup / research organization.
Mode B	Department Internship	Department training + mandatory Live Project.
Mode C	Online Internship	Permitted after the 2nd Semester, for skill enhancement.

Required Documents

Internship Certificate	Project Report	Project Presentation / Viva
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Remember

- Industry Internship (Mode A) is the preferred choice for 2nd & 3rd Year students.
- If you don't get an industry internship, complete the Department Internship (Mode B) with a Live Project.
- No Live Project = No Internship Credit.
